- I can renew my loan, in person, online or by phone, if no one has placed a hold and my record is clear.

I borrow, free of charge

- DVDs
- CD-ROMs
- language courses
- Wii video games
- CDs featuring all kinds of music for my listening pleasure: rock, classical, pop, country, jazz, world music, etc.



And to avoid or reduce fines, I use the loan return drops on bringing back library materials when the library is closed.

From home, over the Internet, I access the nelligan.ville.montreal.qc.ca website to

- check a title
- place a hold on a title
- consult my member file
- renew my loans
- consult periodical indexes and other databases

In the Youth Section, I attend

- the story hour for 3-5-year-olds (except in the summer)
- the story hour in pyjamas and the Summer Reading Club
- the mini-tale* for 2-year-olds (except in the summer)

- I bring my snack and buy myself a coffee or other hot drink.



Attractive Loan and Rental Conditions

The total number of library loans must not be more than 40 and must be in keeping with the limit in certain categories.

- All library materials are loaned for 21 days, except for DVDs and video games (7 days).
- All library loans are FREE, except for book rentals (\$3).
- A member with overdue materials may not borrow anything else.

Adults* (age 14-64)	\$0.25/day
Children (up to age 13) or seniors* (age 65 and over)	\$0.10/day
* \$1/day for book rentals	

My Accès-services Card – I Use it to the Max...

It is required to borrow library materials and take part in the activities at L'Octogone and at all other libraries in the Ville de Montréal network.

It also entitles me to

- swim free of charge in outdoor pools
- take advantage of discounts to skate at the arena, swim at the Aquadôme, take part in various activities organized by the Borough, and more!

Membership conditions and cost

- You must show your driver's licence or two documents giving proof of residence (including one with a photo).
- The card for a minor must be signed by one of the child's parents or a guardian.
- Replacement of a lost or stolen card (with valid membership): \$2 (child/senior) or \$3 (adult)



Residents of Montréal

- The card is **free** and valid for 2 years.

Non-residents of Montréal

- The card is valid for one year (at libraries only) at the following rates:
 - Adults (age 14-64): \$88
 - Children (up to age 13): \$44
 - Seniors (age 65 and over): \$56

Please note: The Accès-services LaSalle card desk closes half an hour before the library does.
